 - T/2020/0143: Stanley Bank.** Fell 1 conifer crown raise above footpath and road 1 yew
 - 7/2020/5618: New Hall, Staveley.** Steel frame building. Prior approval not needed- agricultural building.
 - 7/2020/5657: New Hall, Staveley.** Steel frame building with blue grey fibre cement roofing sheets. **Information only.** (not for discussion)

 - 7/2020/5661: Fairbank Farm, Staveley:** Installation of new access bridge with associated landscaping.
