Minutes of Staveley with Ings Parish Council meeting held on 2nd July 2018 At the Ayland Pavilion, Staveley – 7.15 p.m.

69/18 Apologies: A. Pimblett (domestic) P. Riley (away)

70/18 Declaration of interest - none

71/18 Minutes: it was **resolved** that the Chairman be authorised to sign the minutes of the meeting of the Council held on 4th June 2018 as a true record.

72/18 Public Participation

- The public consultation from Cumbria Highways re Crookfield Footway has been distributed. Councillors asked if the consultation could be widened. Clerk to contact Gill Homes to request this and also ask for posters to be placed.
- The protective post at Scroggs Bridge is loose but it was noted that it has been checked by Cumbria Highways and the bridge has been tarmacked. It was decided to monitor the area and not ask for any action at this time.
- Cllr Capstick reported on a meeting of Community Rail Partnership. A limited shuttle service is now running on the Lakes Line with replacement buses still operating. Some stations have had new ticket machines installed but at Staveley, it was not possible to get the new machine up the stairs.
- An art project on the platform is currently underway involving local artists.
- Mr Ian Stephens, former Chief Executive of Cumbria Tourism was welcomed as a new Councillor.
- A suggestion was made to request the extension of the 40mph. speed limit from Ings to Plantation Bridge. This was rejected as the police have commented that it would bring further problems due to “bunching” of traffic.
- Water is still running across the road on the back road from Bowston. It is thought a blocked culvert may be the cause. Clerk to report to Cumbria Highways.

73/18 Planning Applications

a) New Planning Applications:

7/2018/5283: The Barn, Broadgate Farm, Windermere. Replacement of two small existing windows with a single 2.2 x 2.6 metre patio window. **Fully supported**

T/2018/0070: Stanley Bank, Station Rd- various tree works **Fully supported**

7/2018/5310: Croft House, Crook Rd. Rear extension, balustrading to balcony to rear elevation; alterations to windows and doors to south and west elevations; alterations to existing garage increasing its height. Planning application supported in principle but planners to be notified of concern re potential parking obstruction of historical right of way.

b) To note Planning Applications determined since last meeting

7/2018/5186: 2 Bank Terrace- Provision of one off road parking space. **Agreed with conditions**

T/2018/57: Staveley Fire station: various tree works. **Agreed**

T/2018/58: The Abbey, Main Street. Various tree works **Agreed**

T/2018/038: The Old Corn Mill Staveley. Trim branches on 4 sycamore trees. **Agreed**

7/2018/5229: Barley Bridge, Hall Lane. Repair of scour damage to concrete aprons and installation of additional protection at river level. Partial re-pointing and stonework repair. Partial rebuilding of upstream left-hand wing wall and training wall. **Agreed**

c) To note Planning Applications still outstanding

7/2017/5362: High House Barn, Windermere. Refurbish and extend High House Barn

7/2017/5715: Land to east of Crookfield, Crookfield. Change of use from agricultural grazing land to residential. Construction of 13 dwellings with associated site works.

7/2018/5186: 2 Bank Terrace- Provision of one off road parking space.

T/2018/038: The Old Corn Mill Staveley. Trim branches on 4 sycamore trees

7/2018/5233: 26 Seedfield, Staveley. Single Storey extension and proposed new parking space

74/18 Cumbria Fire Service presentation

- Chief Fire Officer Steve Healey asked for it be minuted the thanks of the Fire Brigade to Cllr Clive Johnson for his outstanding 50 years of service
- A presentation followed that outlined a pilot scheme that is to take place in Staveley and Arnside for a period of 6 months scheduled to start in November. A rapid response vehicle with 3 operatives is to be used instead of a full size fire engine. After this trial period, a public consultation will take place.
- Questions were taken from the general public.

75/18 Strategic Planning – Dr Darrel Smith from Cumbria University outlined a radical new bottom up approach to planning. A pioneer project involving a wide range of stakeholders is to take place which involves mapping ideas and interconnections and community relationships. The map can be used to model what the future will look like with stepping stones put in place to achieve the desired outcome. A computer model that Cumbria Uni has will facilitate. Cllrs Y. Cannon and M. Kidd agreed to assist Mr Smith with the project. The Parish Council gave full support to the project.

76/18 Chairman's report. Cllr Kidd gave a brief report on his first meeting after being elected as a Parish member to LDNP board. He has been placed on committees involving Resources, Property Management and Governance.

77/18 Streetlight meeting – 18th June. The clerk gave a brief report on this meeting which was attended by representatives from 8 Parish Councils. The outcome was not to have further meetings with SLDC and CCC. Other Parishes report all streetlighting problems direct to Cumbria Highways and do not involve their own electricians. It was decided to try out this approach

78/18 Ings Playground official opening ceremony 30th June. Giles Archibald, Leader of SLDC attended. Cllr Kidd gave a short speech thanking SLDC and all sponsors for their contribution and the opening ribbon was duly cut.

79/18 PPWG – 11th June 2018

- Work is set to commence by Gary Wilson on the wall repair. Highways have programmed the work but no timescale is known. They were asked to consider putting 60cm paving slabs into the tarmac and have agreed.
- Cricket Field use would be favoured for Extra Care Housing but the Parish Council does not wish to fund a flood report. The Chief Executive of South Lakes Housing would be interested in a discussion
- No meeting with David Land re Abbey Square railings has yet been arranged.

80/18 Public Space Protection Order & Jacks corner- consultation process.

- PSPO – 108 replies with 66% in agreement. Concern has been expressed regarding policing of it. A public meeting to discuss the survey results was suggested.
- Jack's corner – 80 replies, 95% in agreement. Overwhelming support to retain the name.
- Consultations are still on-going

81/18 Craggy Wood – update - £14,000 has been raised to date, leaving £32,000 still to be found.

82/18 Allotments – update It has been found that it is not possible to remove the stay on the power line as it would be too costly.

83/18 Correspondence: List of correspondence received has been circulated

- It was suggested as Jo Lappin from Cumbria LEP has confirmed attendance in September that preparations are made to present a strong case for the village.
- A Mrs Black sent an e-mail suggesting benches to be placed on Beck Nook and Windermere. This was favourably received but noted that the Parish Council has no money to fund this and the seats would need to be sponsored, i.e. memorial benches.
